

- 6. What sources, primary and otherwise, did you use to verify the historicity of the entry?
- 7. Did you accomplish what you initially set out to do?
- 8. What problems did you run into along the way and how did you solve them?
- 9. What role did creativity play in your project?
- 10. If you did it again, how would you change it? Are there next steps you are planning?






