As the call for our new Baron and Baroness has gone out so here has it been answered. Three couples have stepped forward, offering of their time and talents to lead this Barony to further glory. In the following pages I have included their introductions and thoughts on becoming your next Baron and Baroness. Pray read on and heed their messages.

We will host two <u>Meet and Greet</u> sessions. Each session will be comprised of an introduction by each of the candidates, followed by a question and answer session.

If you are unable to attend either of our Meet and Greet Sessions, <u>please submit questions</u> to our Seneschal. Selected submitted questions will be answered by all of our candidates and be posted with the answers in the next issue of the Mudpuppy. We will also have some of the questions asked at the July meet and greet written up and posted as well. (see page 7)

Our <u>first Meet and Greet</u> will occur at the July Swamp Stomp Picnic at the home of Baroness Jehannine on Sunday July 10th. (see page 2) The meet and greet will start at 2pm. The Barony will sponsor a BBQ providing Burgers and Hotdogs (as well as vegetarian options) and ask that people bring a side dish to share. Prior to the Meet and Greet the Barony will hold its monthly business meeting at 12pm, all are invited to attend. The BBQ will start directly following the business meeting (around 1:30) so that people can grab a bite before we start our Meet and Greet promptly at 2pm.

The <u>second Meet and Greet</u> will take place in our Pennsic encampment prior to our festive party on Thursday night of war week, August 11th. More details on that will follow.

When it was suggested to us that we would be good candidates to run for Baron and Baroness we experienced a sudden range of emotions. We had no idea anyone thought that way about us, that they thought that well of us. We didn't understand that there wasn't a line out the door waiting to become the next landholders. We were sure we weren't qualified and then at the same time suddenly curious about what was necessary to fill the role, realizing that we did not know as much as we thought we did. The overwhelming sensation was that of warmth and inclusion. We both felt special, and loved, and in the hearth of this; adventurous.

We had already started volunteering within the Barony, but only just. I with my role as the keeper of the baronial stuff, and my wife in illuminating scrolls, painting things for largess, and I believe she also helped judge an A&S competition. We'd been members, but also Swampies for a very long time (twenty odd years now). We'd had periods where we had been very active and others not as

Now you may be interested to know why we want to be your Baron and Baroness, and why we think we're capable, you might even be curious why we think we're more capable than the other candidates! All fair questions which I will try and answer as directly as I can.
