Seneschale Elect—Lady Judith bas Rabbi Mendel

At the November 12 officer meeting, the officers of the Barony of Settmour Swamp voted to nominate **Lady Judith bas Rabbi Mendel** as our next Seneschale. Lady Judith's name will be submitted to the Kingdom Seneschale for final approval.

An introduction:

I am Lady Judith bas Rabbi Mendel. As the only surviving child of the esteemed Rabbi Mendel ben Shlomo (may he be remembered for a blessing), I studied Talmud with him from an early age and ultimately inherited his baking business. I currently manage the bakery and my husband's household, and continue the studies that I began with my father as time allows.

My nonfictional husband (Galefridus Peregrinus) and I began attending events in the SCA in 2003 after our oldest child left for college. I knew our youngest would be lonely without her and suggested he find another activity to do since I was only going to be schlepping one child and could fit it into our family schedule. I thought he was going to pick street hockey, but instead he chose the SCA. What he didn't know was that that Galefridus and I had been talking about doing something ourselves that was history-based, and realized that our son's choice coincided with what we were looking for as well.

We found the SCA gave scope to both of our interests. No longer was I the odd duck doing historical costuming on my own—I actually had other people to advise and teach me how to do it better. And since both Galefridus and I are born researchers, it gave us a way to do one of our favorite things — learn about obscure topics and talk to others whose eyes did not immediately glaze over. I have been studying medieval Passovers in northern and Eastern Europe, while he contentedly studies medieval Islamic cooking. Our tiny kitchen has become a laboratory for food experiments, and our pantry is full of odd cooking pots and ingredients. In addition to finding us in kitchens at events, you will find me often doing background service, setting up royal rooms, working at troll, and other mostly invisible tasks. I recently spent three years as chairman of the board of a nonprofit in the Berkshires (ask me about this fantastic place and I'll be glad to tell you more about how it helps people with serious mental illness), but now that my intense volunteer work there has slowed down, I'm able to give more time to helping the barony. I (foolishly?) told Charis, our current seneschal, I would be willing to do more, and was asked to consider serving as seneschal when her term ended. I'm excited to take on this new challenge and help us to be a great Barony. Yours in service.

The **Malleus Maleficarum**, is a **15th century witch hunting manual** written by Heinrich Kramer. Historians typically regard it as a ludicrous and misogynistic text that nonetheless resulted in countless vicious murders of women accused of witchcraft; in **The Salem Witch Trials Reader**, Frances Hill describes it as "one of the most terrifying and obnoxious books ever written."

Joseph fought for about 10 years and was legally blind. He had to stop for several years due to further complications involving his eyes, but was making a comeback when he was diagnosed with cancer. He passed away in July of this year.

Joseph never complained. He never made excuses about what he couldn't do. He inspired those around him. He once participated in a fighting demo where a boy scout attending who also had problems with his eyesight was uninterested until he met Joseph, who showed him what was

possible. Joseph was never a great fighter, but he fought with heart. He fought on the field and he fought until the end of his life.

I wished to bestow his ax on someone who showed the same spirit of never giving up, someone who pushed himself throughout the day. After conferencing with Baron Erec, it was my honor to ask Baron Rory to take possession of the ax, repair it, and use it.
