In the November Mudpuppy you can find my introduction, so this month I'll just recount what is happening in the barony. We had an enjoyable Swamp Stomp earlier this month, ably fed by Halldora and supplemented with yummy potluck contributions.

It may still be December as I write this, but we're working on <u>Mudthaw</u>, scheduled for March 25th at the same location as last year, the Greek Orthodox church in Livingston. This Mudthaw will be the investiture of our new baron and baroness. We need someone to



cook the **feast**. Those interested in serving in this way should contact **Wulfgaar** or **Trehannah**.

A <u>new A&S</u> get together is planned for January 6th and February 4th (see page 2 and page 3). We often hold practices for fencing, fighting, and general A&S; this one will be for <u>cooking</u>. It gives the cooks and food folks among us a place to try out new recipes, talk with others about what they are experimenting with, and get advice on whatever they are struggling with. The Feb. 4 cooking day will be combined with <u>banner making</u> and Pennsic camp beautification projects. The site where this is taking place is large enough for people to come sew and do other A&S projects. See the article on this venture in this issue, or visit the Barony's facebook page for more details.

We are working at submitting a bid for the **<u>Spring Crown Tourney</u>**, but don't know if our bid will be chosen. **<u>Black Gryphon Inn</u>** is scheduled late this year because of renovations to the site; it will be held April 22nd.

It's not too soon to start thinking about <u>Quest</u>—a nice alternative to meditating on snow and ice. We need someone to be the <u>autocrat</u>, to cook the <u>feast</u>, and to plan the <u>quest</u>. Talk with me about it if you are interested. When I autocrated this event several years ago, I found it was not difficult to plan since most of the schedule is already laid out, and most of the work consists of checking with people that they are doing their parts. We now hold the event at the Clinton Elks, and this site makes the planning easier . Autocrating this event is not intimidating, as Jonathan Miles learned last year and wrote about for a recent Mudpuppy.

It is a truth universally acknowledged that with volunteer groups, 80 percent of the work is done by 20 percent of the people. We'd love to have more people involved—it's a good way to get to know people and feel like you are actively contributing. And we will work to make sure it is a positive experience for all. We need a **webminister**, for example, to redesign our website. Ursula is updating the site, but we need someone with more knowledge of web design. Could that be you?

The office duties are as follows (from Lord Jonathan):

- Maintain a time line of swamp events where gear from the locker will be needed.
- Speak with the autocrats, martial-ate, and other activity organizers prior to the event to determine what they will need.
- Set the expectations of how the gear will be moved to and from the event in plain terms. If you are moving it, commit to that. If they are moving it, let them know where and when to show up, and what kind of vehicle to bring. There is no requirement to move the actual gear, and remember that moving things is easy; being a good and accountable facilitator is the key strategy.
- Either bring or facilitate the transport of the needed gear to the event in a timely fashion, and see the gear safely home at the conclusion of the event. Again, do not be afraid to ask for help, no one expects you to move all the gear by yourself.
- Inform the officers of the Barony when anything is not returned, lost, or damaged.
- Respond to the monthly report emails from the officers' list with anything relevant to the gear, its status, or needs for new gear.
- Attend monthly business meetings and offer your vote and experience to the Baronial processes.
- Graciously receive any donations to the Barony and place into storage, thank them sincerely.
- The most important part of the job, to my mind, is to give everyone a sense of confidence that the gear will be onsite and on time.
