

Medieval Sunday – February 8, 2009 Glencairn Museum, Bryn Athyn, Pennsylvania

Medieval Art in the Making: An Illuminating Afternoon Sunday, February 8, 1:00 to 5:00 pm (Snow date February 15)

Watch stained glass windows being painted and a replica Gutenberg-style 1550s printing press in action.

Glencairn Museum is open for guided highlight tours every Saturday. The museum's first floor, including the Great Hall and Upper Hall is open every Saturday free of charge from 11:00AM to 2:30 PM. This past fall the museum was designated a National Historic Landmark.

Medieval art comprises the largest and most significant collection at Glencairn Museum. The core of the collection consists of some 600 objects, mostly French sculpture and stained glass spanning the years 1100-1300. The Museum has two medieval galleries and many works of stained glass and sculpture are installed in the Great Hall. There is also an Egyptian Gallery and a Roman Gallery, which includes two sarcophagi.




