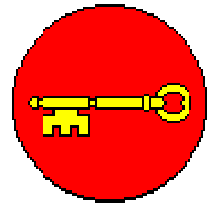

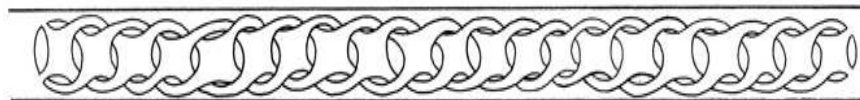

If you'd like to camp with the Barony at Pennsic, first you must first pre-register for Pennsic with Cooper's Lake Campground by their deadline of May 15, mailed-in /June 15 online, 2010 – online Pennsic registration is available with credit card at www.pennsicwar.org. Next, you must fill out each section of this form and return it, along with a camp fee of \$25 payable to 'SCA Inc. – Barony of Settmour Swamp', to Victoria Conlin, no later than the deadline of July 17, 2010. In order for this form to be accepted we need to have at least, your **Mundane name, contact info and tent dimensions**. If you prefer to wait to Pennsic to pay the camp fee that is not a problem. Mailing Address for forms and payment is: Victoria Conlin, 35 East Shore Lake Owassa Road, Newton, NJ 07860. The camping fees collected are to cover the costs of the communal tent, firewood, camp shower, water, ice and other miscellaneous expenses associated with organizing the encampment. Everyone in camp will be expected to help out with breaking down the encampment at the end of the war. This will occur on Friday so it is done before the great exodus on Saturday. If anyone would like to volunteer to be in charge of this function it could be done on Saturday. Many hands make for lighter work! Please when you break down your camp site **DO NOT** leave your trash in camp please take them to the dumpster before you go.

Caveats: Because by law we are not allowed to ask for personal medical information, there are no medical exemptions, please choose to camp responsibly. Exemptions from priority assignment, but not from land allocation square footage limitations are: Baron and Baroness of Settmour Swamp, Baronial Seneschal, and Settmour Swamp Land Agent(s).

Camping Assignments

The point system has been designed to assign priority for preferred camping at Pennsic (i.e., treeline) in a fair and consistent manner, taking into account both seniority as well as service to the Barony. Points are cumulative, but only one type of event-related tally is allowed for each event, demo and/or workshop, since last Pennsic. Here are the point values assigned to various contributions to the Barony:

Years camped with Settmour at Pennsic	1 point for each year
Autocrat at an Event	5 points for each event
Head Cook at an Event	5 points for each event
Key Staff Position at an Event	2 points for each event
Volunteer Staff at an Event	1 point for each event
Demo or Workshop Participation	1 point for each demo/workshop
Baronial/Canton Officer	5 points
Order of the Silver Tower	5 points
Order of the Bronze Tower	2 points
Canvas period-style tent	2 points
Each 25sq.ft. over total land allotment	Minus 2 points
Whining	Minus 100 points

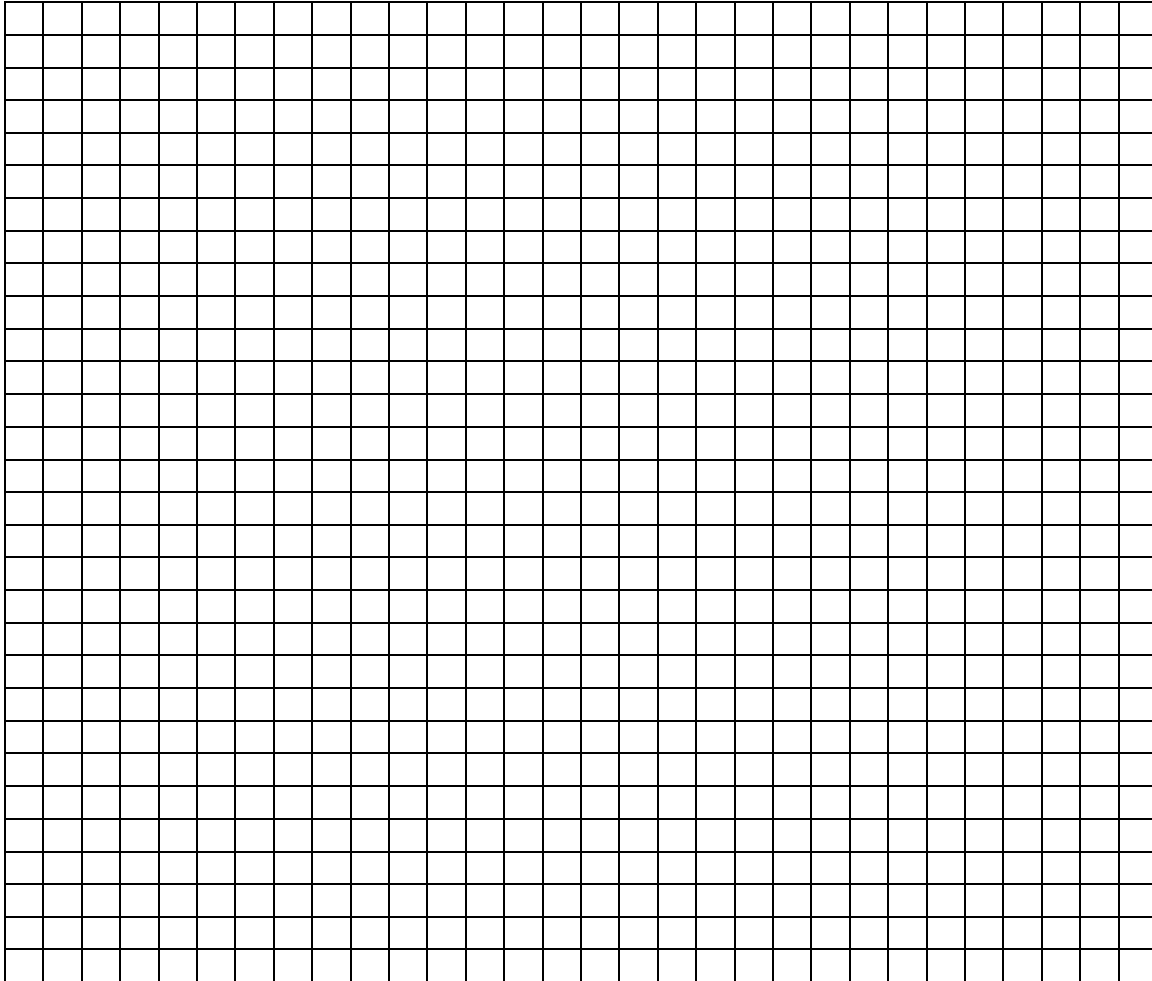
The Pennsic land office has initially designated 250 square feet for each pre-registered camper, though in past years there has been mandatory reductions imposed on large encampments. Each camper is asked to contribute 75 square feet of their Pennsic land allotment to be used for the walkways and common areas within the Baronial encampment, which leaves 175 square feet in personal camping space per person.

Land allotment is cumulative for multiple campers sharing the same tent, however, placement will be according to the pre-registered camper with the highest point value. For people who want to camp together (i.e. adjacent) in separate tents, placement is according to the average point value of the pre-registered campers in the group. If camping as a group, please choose a common group name and list it here:

Tent Dimensions and Specifications

Please use the graph paper below to draw a scaled picture of your exact tent dimensions and shape, including all guy ropes, awnings, and supplemental tents. Don't forget to shade in a one-foot safety boundary around your tent's perimeter (e.g., if your tent is 10' x 10', adding a one-foot safety boundary makes it measure 12' x 12', and your total square footage used would be 144 sq. ft.). It is also very important to indicate where your door is located, so it can be oriented to face a walkway. Each square on the grid below represents one square foot.

Please remember that the layout of the baronial encampment varies from year to year and is not perfectly symmetrical, so some adjustments may be necessary. The camp will be arranged as faithfully as possible according to the point value system and tent space requirements. If you have any preferences exclusive to the point system, (i.e., prefer flat ground to shade, prefer closer to portajohns, etc.), please indicate it here:

Each year we have trouble matching up everyone on the Pennsic pre-reg list to tents in camp. It is hard for us to know if we are missing tent information. Please list all pre-registered individuals who are planning to camp in your tent and who's land allotment is going towards your tent. So if your friend from college or work wants to go to war but is not sure he/she can make but registers just in case please list his/her name here so we can account for them. Also any minors who you have registered even if there is a chance they will not be able to go. The adults will need to fill out there own form this is just for our reference of who is registered and camping in your tent.

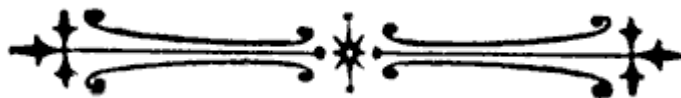
