Writ for the Order of the Pelican

Gryffyth the King and Aikaterine the Queen to Alexander MacGregor, Baron of Settmour Swamp, greetings.

We command you, strictly enjoining you, by the faith which you owe us, to present your person by all means at our Court upon the 26th of March in the forty-fifth year of the Society, at the annual festival of the thawing of the mud as celebrated in the lands which you hold in fief from us, thereupon to sit vigil and take advice from such Peers of the Realm as there be present and further to answer this solemn query: whether to accept the accolade of the Order of the Pelican from Our hands.

Text by Mistress Alys Mackyntoich, based upon Edward I's summons of peers to Parliament, 9

March 1304.



Congratulations to Erik the Wandering Horseman, who at Twelfth Night, was inducted into the Order of the Silver Crescent.

The Order of the Silver Crescent (established June 13, A.S. 6 by Akbar III and Khadijah III) may be given to gentles in the East Kingdom who have distinguished themselves by service to the Kingdom, whether by long service within one of the areas of the Kingdom whereby the entire Kingdom is held to benefit, or by continuing service in ways which directly benefit a large portion of the Kingdom.

New York City Public Library Road Trip

Got a research project in mind, but don't know where to start? On Saturday, February 5th (snow day February 19), we will be travelling to the New York Public Library (NYPL) for a day of research. Galefridus will be your guide for the day -- mundanely, he is an academic librarian, so if there is anything to find on your topic, he can do it.

Anyone who plans on coming should devote some time thinking about the specifics of what you're looking for. A specific topic (13th century French recipes for veal, e.g.) is much easier to work with than a general topic (medieval European cooking, e.g.) Feel free to contact Galefridus privately if you have any questions.

In addition to the research session, NYPL currently has two exhibits of interest:

- 1. Their copy of the Gutenberg Bible is on display
- 2. They have what looks like an excellent exhibit on the scribal traditions of Judaism, Christianity and Islam -- for more information:

This is the NYPL research library at Fifth Avenue and 42nd Street, easily accessible by public transportation. We will be meeting in the gift shop shortly after it opens at 10am.

A post-trip visit to one of NYC's better beer bars, the Pony Bar -http://www.theponybar.com/ is also planned.

- Folks should bring a decent-sized USB flash drive to download information.
- No scanners are available, so bring cash for photocopying.
- If you have a laptop, bring it -- it will be easier than trying to reserve multiple workstations,

- Computer workstations can be reserved only by folks with a valid NYPL card, which can be
 obtained only by folks who work, go to school, or live in the State of NY.
- There is no cafeteria within the library, so we will go someplace for lunch within the immediate area.
