Work is proceeding on the Seder. Charis and I conferred at length about the food. She is working on pricing out the menu we are considering and thinks she may be able to do it for \$10/person. We're going to revisit the site later this week to help her figure out what is possible to do in that kitchen. So far, the menu will include lamb and a chicken stew. I've drawn up a basic budget. The costs are pretty basic:budget approved

That comes to \$18/person, with a break even number of 90.

One issue to consider is how to make sure there is wine for the meal. The hall has no problem with us serving it, but we need to comply with SCA rules on the serving of alcohol. Decided on grape juice with participants to bring own wine if they wish.

I am continuing my work on the ceremony itself. I am also looking for an oven to use in making the matzah. It needs to go higher than the normal kitchen oven that can reach 525-550 degrees.
