# Socus on the Arts

Our featured artist this month is Sof'ia Zhirinskaia. Sof'ia's area of interest is textile and fiber arts.



**Q**: How long have you been in the SCA?

A: Three years.

**Q**: Have you always lived in Settmour Swamp or have you played with different groups during your SCA life?

A: I've always lived in Settmour.

**Q:** Do you have a persona? If so, please tell us about it.

A: My persona is Sof'ia Zhirinskaia, wife of a rich Kievan Rus fur trader living in 10<sup>th</sup> Century Kiev. I spin, weave, nalbind, embroider, make clothing and paint for my family and friends.

**Q**: Do you have any Baronial or Kingdom level awards? If so what are they?

A: I have an AOA, Bronze Tower, and am the current Baronial A&S Champion.

Q: Are you an apprentice, protégé, or squire? If yes, with whom are you affiliated?

A: I am a student of Lady Elisabeth Elenore Lovell.

**Q:** What arts and sciences do you practice?

A: Spinning, knitting, painting, Viking wire knitting, nalbinding, sprang, tablet weaving, lucet, garb making and beading.

**Q:** Where did you learn your skills and from whom did you learn?

A: Most of my skills have been self taught, but I do learn a great deal from taking classes at Pennsic.

**Q**: Are there any areas of arts and sciences that you would like to learn about or any skills you would like to practice that you don't already?

A: I would like to learn more about Icon painting, illumination, woodworking, metal work, glass making, natural dyes and pigments.

**Q:** What project(s) have you completed that you are most proud of?

A: Reproduction of a 14<sup>th</sup> Century Knitted Sion Purse. It was created using fine silk thread on size 0000 needles, 16 stitches to the inch to replicate the gauge that was used to make the extant piece. I entered this piece and won the Settmour Swamp Baronial A&S Championship.

**Q**: What are you working on now?

A: Baronial favors, several icons, sprang purse, Viking chests, painted boxes and a secret project for Northern Lights. It's a secret because I'm not sure I will be able to pull it off in time!

**O:** What projects do you have planned for the coming year?


A: In the works are a quilted Elizabethan underskirt, wood block printing, wood carving and double faced tablet weaving.

**Q:** Of the A&S skills you possess, which do you think you would be able to teach to others?

A: Spinning, Viking wire knitting, sprang, knitting, tablet weaving and making garb.

**Q:** Are you willing to share your knowledge with the populous? If so how can you be contacted should someone be interested in leaning from you?

A: I am happy to share my knowledge with the populous. I teach at Pennsic and at local events. I am also available at most Flemington practices for those interested in learning what I know.


