Fall Schola - Nos Calan Gaeaf

Rapier Championship

We withdrew our bid because the price of the site went up.

Mudthaw

The date will be March 23rd. We need a site. Markus put out a call for an autocrat.

Black Gryphon Inn

Gryphonwald runs this event. BGI will be at the same site as last year, on February 25th. Lucas is autocrating again.

Demo

Eva said Hillsboro High School Theater Program would like a demo focusing on the Renaissance and Shakespeare on Sunday, November 4th. They want help being accurate. Is there any interest? We agreed that if the chatelaine is unable to attend, this demo would be difficult. Eva will find out more details.

Officer Terms

Seneschal – The officers voted in favor of having Markus continue in this position for another vear.

Social Media Officer – This position needs to be posted online.

Other Business

Charis received a thank you note from the King and Queen of Trimaris who attended our party at Pennsic and thanked us for our hospitality. Charis felt it wasn't just the baron and baroness who should know of the letter, but all who came and made the party happen.

Youth Combat

Sir Douglas has equipment to give back to the barony. Markus suggested giving it to Jonathan Miles since he wants to work on youth fighting.

Sites

Gwenhoivar mentioned the 4 H Camp has limited capacity. They do not have a lot of cover if it rains.

Officer Reports

<u>Heraldry:</u> Alys sent a message: I am taking over as Eastern Crown Herald (chief of Their Majesties' heraldic staff) at Coronation. All required reports have been filed. We will be having a heraldic track class at the Schola that will include classes on names, armory, and vocal heraldry.

<u>Mol</u>: Ciaran sent a report by email also: Not much is happening. He is trying to find opportunities for Emidio to get training. Markus mentioned he'd also like to learn.

Marshal of Fence: Wulfgar raised the suggested donation for fencing practice from \$7 to \$10. We have raised enough in donations over the last three weeks. Drew has a dance studio that might work as an alternative place to practice. We need more information from them. Wulfgar mentioned he'd like to move the practices back to Tuesday nights. Alger is now the baronial champion for Carillion. New people have been coming to the practices, and there have been new authorizations.

<u>Knight Marshal</u>: Douglas reported that over 30 people came to the Nutley practice last week. No injuries.

<u>Chronicler</u>: When issues go up online, we need to tell Markus, Hrefna, and Dalek so it can be publicized. Hrefna will look into emailing either a pdf or just highlights.

<u>Chatelaine</u>: Gwenhoivar asked if we could get more baronial business cards made. Markus suggested adding QR codes.

<u>A&S</u>: Natal'ia said A&S has been happening at the fencing practice. Natal'ia is looking to set up a gathering at the Great Swamp Watershed Association. A metalworking class is planned for this weekend. Natal'ia is also trying to schedule online A&S gatherings on a regular basis. Regarding the baronial tshirts, she will start the process after the schola.

<u>Exchequer</u>: Vika said she had nothing to add this month. We have money in the bank. We need to pay for the schola up front but that will be repaid by gate receipts.

<u>Webminister</u>: Dalek needs to see where we are with updating the website.

<u>Social Media</u>: Hrefna said they had nothing of note to report. She will post about the upcoming schola. Feel free to pass it on.

<u>Captain of the Archers</u>: Silvanus said they've been hammered by the weather. The prediction for the upcoming weekend is more rain.

<u>Chamberlain</u>: Emeline asked what we need from storage for the schola. Charis will pick up stuff from storage locker with her trailer. It was decided that we only need a few items from Gold Key.

The minutes from July were approved.

Fall Schola - Nos Calan Gaeaf

The site where we were planning to hold the event has raised its rent. We are trying to negotiate with them and in the meantime will look at other sites. Elizabeth asked people to sign up to teach classes. If you would like to learn something, please tell her and she will try to find a teacher.

Rapier Championship

The price here is also changing. Shire of Hartshorn-dale is also submitting a bid for this event. We may withdraw our bid because of the cost.

Black Gryphon Inn

Gryphonwald has been trying to figure out a date. The date that is available is Sunday, February 25th.

Mudthaw

Markus asked whether we want to use Vasa Park again. Last year 510 people came. The site only has 200 parking spots, and 60 of them are used for the lists. Any place we rent we'll still have difficulties if the weather is nasty. Fighting would still have to take place outside.

We discussed possible dates. We would need to hold Mudthaw on March 23 if we wanted it to be a Royal Progress. We have been penciled in for that date at Vasa Park.

Baronial T-shirts

Natal'ia is interesting in putting on a T-shirt design contest for the barony. She is thinking of having two t-shirts—one general baronial and one crew shirt (Team Settmour, for example). The deadline winner will be given a t-shirt with their own design. She is thinking of making the shirts a fundraiser. It was agreed that we should advertise the contest soon so artists can start working on their designs. Natal'ia will do research on sites that do on-demand printing.

Officer Terms

The terms for the Social Media Officer and Seneschal are ending soon. Markus needs a deputy who is interested in becoming the next seneschal.

Exchequer

After 18 months of analysis, here is the Barony's financial status:

- The Barony's expected annual net income from events is about \$3200 (Quest & Mudthaw primarily; and a bit from smaller events such as scholas, champions days, etc). Note that, starting next year, all RPs (including Mudthaw) will fall under Kingdom profit sharing, and this has been taken into account.
- The Barony's future annual expense for the storage unit is about \$2700. (It was over 6K per year before we consolidated to a single unit this past April.)
- We have spent down most of our cash reserves we need to retain about \$10K in the bank for fluidity, especially for pre-event expenses for Mudthaw. Therefore, for a few years we need to clamp down on expenditures that won't pay for themselves.
- The average monthly cost of the fencing practice is \$400, and the average monthly income from fencing practice donations is \$170. This isn't sustainable. We either need to guarantee attendance, find another way to cover the funding gap, or not use this site.

Much discussion on how to approach these issues, including: finding ways to expand the fencing practice/make it attractive to more attendees, e.g. the Rusted Woodlands fencers who just lost their site; looking for other sites; approaching event budgeting with an eye towards making a profit (including not keeping the entry fee artificially low - but finding ways to make events accessible to people who are struggling financially); holding fundraisers; running more large events.

[All are encouraged to read the full minutes on this topic, as it impacts all members of the Barony.]

Officer Reports

<u>A&S</u>: Natal'ia said she has a new deputy, Iseaulte of the Clews. They are encouraging people interested in doing scribal to come to the weekly fencing practice where there will be A&S at the same time. Karin Jacobsdottir wants to teach a metal jewelry class for six participants on October 14th. Natal'ia is working on planning the next quarterly A&S hangout. She has been hosting A&S open forums online and wants to do them 1-2 times a month on Sunday nights. She also mentioned the need for largesse items.

<u>Chatelaine</u>: Gwenhoivar said she heard today from a former Scadian who wants to play again. While at Pennsic, she also heard from someone interested in medieval music. Jadwega asked if we would be interested in doing a demo at the Plainfield Public Library.

<u>Exchequer</u>: Vika asked when offices change hands, that the new officer give her the date of their membership renewal and their blue card number to include in reports she submits.

<u>Heraldry:</u> Alys said they have gotten a lot of submissions. She will start video classes in October. The upcoming schola will have a heraldic track. Markus asked if there is a baronial populace badge.

MoL: Emidio is looking for upcoming events he can shadow the MoL at.

Social Media: Hrefna said they had nothing much to report.

<u>Captain of the Archers</u>: Silvanus cancelled recent practices because of the weather. A practice is planned for this week.

<u>Marshal of Fence</u>: Alger said Sparta is holding a Ren Faire and would like more demo folks for the next two weeks. The Lakewood Ren Faire is coming up soon.

<u>Chronicler</u>: The Q2 issue of Mudpuppy is up on the website.

Knight Marshal: Practice started back up on August 30th.

<u>Chamberlain</u>: Emeline said she had checked on the stuff in the storage unit recently.

<u>Webminister</u>: Cuilean MacFhionnlaigh is Dalek's deputy. Simon Talbot will continue his work on account management.

Next meeting: Will be virtual. Next meeting will be Tuesday, October 10th, at 7:30 pm. The link will be posted. All are welcome to attend.

Pennsic

Hekja reported that they are working on tetrising the tents and the chore chart. They have ordered what they could ahead of time. 95 real people have registered to camp with the Swamp. We will have the same amount of space as last year.

Bids for Crown

We have submitted our bid, with Ashling and Martina autocrating. Galefridus will mentor. The royals will consider our bid if the Central region of the kingdom is unable to run the event because this is an event that moves around the kingdom on a set schedule.

Canal Day

They contacted Jonathan today. Markus reached out to our chatelaine, but she is unable to participate on that date. This event takes place a week after Pennsic when we are all exhausted. We need someone to run the demo, almost like an autocrat.

Officer Reports

<u>Heraldry:</u> Alys reported that she will not be going to Pennsic, but someone is lined up to run baronial court at Pennsic. All reports are in except for Mudthaw because she did not know what awards were given out there.

A&S: Natal'ia wants to have crafting days/hours using the Swamp Mead Hall at Pennsic. On July 22nd there will be a class on Tudor knitting. It has been posted on FaceBook. Other A&S gatherings will be scheduled after Pennsic.

MoL: Ciaran said he had nothing new to report. Emidio is now his deputy.

<u>Chamberlain</u>: Laundered Gold Key has been returned to storage unit. Almost everything is back from the last event.

<u>Chatelaine</u>: They had one request for a demo that was for that week so it didn't work.

Webminister: Dalek said the most recent updates went well.

<u>Exchequer</u>: Vika said our finances are stable. Kingdom had some issues with some of our old reports from 2021-2022; their editing will have no material impact. Markus recommended that we project our costs for the year. Vika suggested it be done in September. We need to take into account our general operating expenses when we pick a price for events. As of January, 2024, Kingdom will take 50% of net at Royal Progresses. That affects Mudthaw, Ducal, and any kingdom events we do.

Knight Marshal: Markus said fighting is happening; no injuries.

<u>Marshal of Fence</u>: Wulfgar reported that the fencers have been fencing outdoors at the site because of the heat. Attendance has been low—some folks have moved and so are no longer coming. There have been some new authorizations. He and Alger marshalled at Novice Day.

<u>Social Media</u>: Thora said they've been getting occasional questions; things have been very quiet.

They'll be putting up tips for Pennsic and want a stockpile of photos.

<u>Chronicler</u>: Markus recommends that we do 4 issues/year with a list of officers, upcoming events, and minutes of business meetings. In between we can do issues with more interesting articles. Haldora has made a template for the layout.

Next meeting: Will be virtual. There will be no August meeting. Next meeting will be Tuesday, <u>September 12th</u>, at 7:30 pm. The link will be posted. All are welcome to attend.

Summary of Baronial Business Meeting Minutes June 13, 2023 Held virtually

We approved February, March, April, and May meetings.

Quest – Eva reported

The event ran smoothly. F216 adults attended, and 28 children. Lots of young people came; also lots of new people. How do we keep them engaged?

Eva recommended we make some changes to the event spreadsheet. We should also take into account administrative costs of running the barony when we set the fees for events. Markus will work with Vika on this.

Pennsic

Swamp Camp is big this year—108 have preregistered. Eva made a hard push to get people to come and register. Camp forms are due in early July, and the layout will be done after July 5th. A team of people are working on figuring out the layout.

Bids for Coronation/Crown

A team of people interested in working on these events met yesterday. It was decided to submit bids for both coronation and Crown, and let the royals decide which one they'd like us to do. We'd only do one.

In calculating the price to attend, we should take into account that the Kingdom wants to make money off of the event. Because it is a Kingdom event, the profits get split 50/50 between the hosting group and the Kingdom. The dates the royals are interested in conflict with some other events going on in the Kingdom.

<u>Coronation</u>: Natal'ia and Emidio are working on this The hardest part is finding a place to hold it. The sites that meet our requirements best are the most expensive. They are estimating that 350 people might attend. Several people volunteered to fill key positions: The bid is due June 15.

<u>Crown</u>: Lucas has found a site: 4H of East Brunswick. Ashling (who volunteered to co-autocrat) is looking at alternative sites that would be inside.

Ducal
